#### 1. WHAT THIS POLICY IS FOR

Please read this cookie policy carefully as it contains important information on who we are and how we use cookies on our website. #### 4. COOKIES

- 4.1. A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your device (e.g. computer, smartphone or other electronic device) when you use our website. We use the following cookies on our website:
  - Strictly necessary cookies. These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.
  - Performance cookies. These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure
    and improve the performance of our site. They help us to know which pages are the most and least
    popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated
    and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited
    our site, and will not be able to monitor its performance.
  - Functionality cookies. These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalisation. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our pages. If you do not allow these cookies then some or all of these services may not function properly.
  - Targeting cookies. These cookies may be set through our site by our advertising partners. They may
    be used by those companies to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant adverts on other
    sites. They do not store directly personal information, but are based on uniquely identifying your
    browser and internet device. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted
    advertising.

OptanonConsent	This cookie is set by the cookie compliance solution from OneTrust. It stores information about the categories of cookies the site uses and whether visitors have given or withdrawn consent for the use of each category. This enables site owners to prevent cookies in each category from being set in the users browser, when consent is not given. The cookie has a normal lifespan of one year, so that returning visitors to the site will have their preferences remembered. It contains no information that can identify the site visitor. _ga	This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics - which is a significant update to Google's more commonly used analytics service. This cookie is used to distinguish unique users by assigning a randomly generated number as a client identifier. It is included in each page request in a site and used to calculate visitor, session and campaign data for the sites analytics reports. By default it is set to expire after 2 years, although this is customisable by website owners.	Performance
_gclxxxx _hjSessionUser_2375638	Google conversion tracking cookie  Hotjar cookie that is set when a user first lands on a page with the Hotjar script. It is used to persist the Hotjar User ID, unique to that site on the browser. This ensures that behavior in subsequent visits to the same site will be attributed to the same user ID.
